

If your tires are on the list above, and you have not received a notification letter, and you cannot otherwise prove a new tire purchase date of on or after June 1, 1977, Firestone will assume that you purchased them new on or after June 1, 1977 providing that:

1. Your tires came as original equipment on a 1977 or later model vehicle and have serials showing production on or after March 1, 1977 (serial numbers ending 097 or later).
2. Your tires were purchased as replacements and have serials showing production on or after December 1, 1976 (serial numbers ending 496 or later).

### **WHAT TIRES WILL I RECEIVE AS REPLACEMENTS?**

Except for GR70-15 tires (500-5 rib or TPC) on Chevrolet Corvettes, and NR78-15 TPC tires, you have your choice (in same size or metric equivalent) of Firestone 721 or TPC—or, if you desire, Firestone Trax 12 (all season tire) or Town & Country Steel Belted Radial (winter) tires. Unless Trax 12 or Town & Country are requested, TPC tires should be replaced with TPC, and Firestone 500 tires with the Firestone 721.

The recommended replacement for tires on Chevrolet Corvettes is the Firestone Super 125 Radial GR70-15 or P225/70R15 size. The GR70-15 TPC is the only other permissible replacement for Chevrolet Corvette tires. NR78-15 TPC tires will be replaced only with the 8.90-15 New Deluxe Champion 2-Stripe tire.

Under the free replacement program, if you choose a replacement tire that is lower priced than the current equivalent of your eligible recall tire, you are not entitled to cash rebate or other consideration, and you will be required to sign a waiver authorizing such replacement.

If you have eligible tires that qualify for replacement under the half-price prorata tread wear program, your replacement price will be based on Firestone's adjustment base price of the replacement tire at time of replacement under this recall.

### **WHEN MUST I PRESENT MY ELIGIBLE TIRES FOR REPLACEMENT?**

If your tires qualify for free replacement, you must present them within 60 days of receiving your notification letter from Firestone—or by September 30, 1980 if you do not receive a notification letter. If replacements are not available when you present tires that are eligible for free replacement, keep your tires and documents until replacement tires are available. You will then have 60 days from the date the Firestone dealer or store informs you that they have received tires for you to affect the replacement. Any recall replacement made thereafter will be made only under the half-price/prorata tread wear program.
